**RE: Street Closure for Restoration of Chesterfield Road**

Dear Valued Customer:

The Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority (PWSA), in coordination with the City of Pittsburgh Department of Mobility and Infrastructure (DOMI), has determined a restoration plan for Chesterfield Road following water main and lead line replacements. The road will be closed to all traffic and parking 24/7 during restoration. Due to stormwater flow concerns and in efforts to preserve the look of the street, we will be re-installing the Belgian blocks as it was before.

Work is anticipated to begin the week of May 22<sup>nd</sup>, in conjunction with the end of the spring college semester. PWSA and its contractor, A. Folino Construction Inc., are committed to completing the work as quickly as possible and will fully staff the jobsite until it is complete. Crews will work Monday – Friday from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and may work on weekends to meet construction deadlines. As with all work throughout the project, restoration is weather-dependent and subject to change. We ask that residents move any large items from their properties by Sunday, May 21<sup>st</sup> to avoid conflicts with the street closure. If you are planning to move out during this time, please contact us and we will work with you during weekend hours.

PWSA's project team has coordinated with trash and recycling services to ensure your trash is picked up as normal. Crews will accommodate EMS vehicles that need to access the street in the event of an emergency. Restoration of the street is anticipated to be complete by August 1, meaning work will last approximately 10 weeks.
