Starship Technologies is building a fleet of autonomous personal delivery devices ("PDDs") designed to deliver goods locally in 15-60 minutes. Launched by two Skype co-founders, Ahti Heinla and Janus Friis, Starship Technologies' aim is to fundamentally reshape how goods are shipped and delivered, making local deliveries more convenient, environmentally efficient, and less expensive.

Starship Technologies maintains its business headquarters in San Francisco and its R&D headquarters in Estonia. Lex Bayer serves as the company's CEO and Ahti Heinla is the CTO.

Starship Technologies is currently commercially available in the United States, United Kingdom, Germany, and Estonia with partners like Sodexo, Daimler AG, Intuit, Tesco, Coop, Volkswagen, Novo Nordisk, Bayer, and others, offering PDD delivery for food, grocery and parcel industries. Starship Technologies' PDDs have now covered over 350,000 miles in 20 countries and over 100 cities, encountering more than 15 million people.
